

RESIDENT STREAM: *TRANSITION TO PRACTICE*

The Ontario Psychiatric Association has created a new program to facilitate the challenge of navigating the transition from residency to independent practice. The morning session will feature presentations focusing on practice management topics such as understanding OHIP billings and accounting considerations. The afternoon session will provide a brief orientation to planning for key milestones and will offer an interactive panel featuring psychiatrists practicing in a variety of settings to help residents consider the breadth of available models.

1. To plan for ways to optimize the final year of residency in preparation for independent practice.
2. To consider a range of practice models that are available in both academic and community settings post-residency.
3. To learn about billings and other financial considerations when engaging in independent practice.
